



MBH House Member Guidelines

For women to live together safely and somewhat harmoniously and practically, each house member must agree to abide by a few sensible and practical "rules." Not following these rules consistently can not only result in chaos, but eventual termination of residency.

Weekly House Meetings: participate in a friendly, casual, and purposeful gathering of each house member, organized by our in-house resident assistant, Kitt Smith.

Weekly House Inspections: prepare for weekly or biweekly "walk-throughs" of the house inside and out, conducted by the owner, GibAnn Berryhill. Purpose is to check for general cleanliness and order, and manage any maintenance issues.

Nightly Curfew: each house member should be in the house by midnight each night, as the doors are bolted and the house alarm set.

Managing Groceries: Each house member will have designated space for their own groceries. If meals are periodically prepared in common, arrangements for sharing costs and groceries should be agreed upon in advance.

Visitors: Overnight visitors are not allowed. House members may have visitors on visiting days (3 days per week). No more than 1 visitor per house member may visit at one time and no longer than 2 hours each time. Male visitors are only allowed in the living / dining / kitchen areas. Visitors who cause problems will not be allowed to return.

Kindness, courtesy, self-control, and honesty: To live together, these qualities must be developed and practiced consistently.

Care of the Premises: House members will take care of the inside of the house, keeping it clean and free of careless or intentional damage. They will also keep the sidewalks and patio swept.
